

Vermont State Housing Authority Montpelier ADU Program Order of Operations



This form is designed to give you a rough order in which to go about completing the necessary steps for creating your apartment. This may change per individual projects. The VT State Housing Authority (VSHA) will be available to guide you through the process, answer questions, meet with contractors, and assist with zoning and compliance as needed. In order to comply with program funders, it is very important to complete certain tasks before moving on to the next. **DO NOT** start any work or move on to new tasks before consulting with VSHA.

 $VSHA\ will\ determine\ if\ the\ project\ meets\ guidelines\ for\ the\ Montpelier\ ADU\ Program\ and\ do\ a\ site\ visit$
 Contact Audra Brown at the City of Montpelier at: 802-223-9506 ext. 135 regarding zoning/permits
 Determine what your budget will be for the project
 Come up with a basic design, rough drawings, and plan for the project
 VSHA will conduct the Environmental Review process
 Secure financing for the project (savings, HELOC, construction loan, etc.)
 Create more detailed drawings and specifications
 Obtain City zoning and construction permits as required
 Get clearance from VSHA to proceed with your ADU project
 Get quotes from contractor(s)
 Choose contractor(s) and create a work schedule/timeline
 Create the apartment
 Contact the City of Montpelier and VSHA when work is complete
 Contact VSHA to schedule a final walkthrough
 Create lease documents and search for a tenant
 Contact your Homeowners Insurance agent to inform of change
 Lease up with the new tenant
